WARWICK NEARLY SOLD OUT

A major Philadelphia condominium conversion project has canceled its sales grand opening after nearly selling-out, a month before unveiling a regional marketing campaign to the public. The Warwick Condominium, which announced plans to convert the top eight floors of Philadelphia's legendary Warwick Hotel to 100 condominiums in late September of this year, had planned to officially unveil the project in early January 2006. Those plans, however, have been cancelled due to unexpectedly high demand for The Warwick's studios, one, two, and three-bedroom condominiums located one-half block from Rittenhouse Square, at 1701 Locust Street in Center City.

Allan Domb Real Estate is developing the Warwick Condominium in partnership with Frankel Enterprises, which owned the Warwick Hotel from 1978 to 1998, and has developed a number of the City's most desirable residential properties, including William Penn House, Kennedy House, 220 West Rittenhouse Square, Parkway House, and the Wellington Apartments.
